Required Equipment:

- Reliable pump action or semi-auto shotgun with a sling (12 or 20 gauge, high capacity shotguns are preferred)
- 20 rds of 00 buckshot (duty rounds)
- 20 rds of slug (duty rounds)
- 500 rds of birdshot (#7 or #8 preferred)
- Sturdy belt
- Semi-automatic pistol (full-size pistols are recommended) with a strong side hip holster (Shoulder holsters, ankle holsters, and fanny bags are not permitted), and 50 rds of pistol ammo.
- Hearing protection, eye protection, and a billed baseball-style cap **are mandatory**. Knee pads are optional, but recommended.
- Body armor is recommended. Note taking material and cell phone (camera/video) are also recommended.
