



## East Texas Police Academy Civilian Attendance

Civilians are generally permitted to attend training courses at the East Texas Police Academy. Prior to civilian enrollment in any East Texas Police Academy course, the following documentation must be on file with the East Texas Police Academy:

- Written documentation that the person is not currently charged with any criminal offense for which a conviction would be a bar to licensure
- Written documentation that the person is not currently on court-ordered community supervision or probation for any criminal offense
- Written documentation that the student is not prohibited by state or federal law from possessing firearms or ammunition

Documentation establishing these criteria includes, but is not limited to:

- A professional license issued by any State which requires compliance with the above mentioned criteria
- A sworn and notarized affidavit affirming the above mentioned criteria
- A Criminal History check (may be performed by ETPA)

Note: Civilians enrolling in any training course offered by the East Texas Police Academy are subject to a Criminal History check. In certain instances, the Director of the East Texas Police Academy may prohibit civilians from enrolling in training offered by the East Texas Police Academy.
